
The Department of Defense is transitioning from its current paper-based Uniformed Services Identification (USID) card to a more secure, **next generation USID card**. **Currently-issued USID cards** remain valid through their expiration date.

Common Access Card (CAC)

Armed Forces of the United States Geneva Conventions Identification Card.

(This is the standard card for active duty personnel in accordance with Geneva Convention Requirements. See the sample card below.)
